To All To Whom these Presents shall come,-GREETING:

WHEREAS by an Instrument of Abdication, dated the tenth day of December instant, His former Majesty King Edward the Eighth did declare His irrevocable determination to renounce the Throne for Himself and His descendants, and the said Abdication has now taken place, whereby the Imperial Crown of Great Britain, Ireland and all other His former Majesty's dominions is now solely and rightfully come to the High and Mighty Prince Albert Frederick Arthur George, Now Know YE that I, the said Right Honourable Baron Tweedsmuir of Elsfield, Governor General of Canada as aforesaid, assisted by His Majesty's Privy Council for Canada, do now hereby with one voice and consent of tongue and heart publish and proclaim that the High and Mighty Prince Albert Frederick Arthur George is now become our only lawful and rightful Liege Lord George the Sixth by the Grace of God of Great Britain, Ireland and the British dominions beyond the Seas KING, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India, to whom we acknowledge all faith and constant obedience with all hearty and humble affection, beseeching God by whom all Kings and Queens do reign to bless the Royal Prince George the Sixth with long and happy years to reign over us.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at Arms at Ottawa, this twelfth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirtysix, and in the first year of His Majesty's reign.

Now, THEREFORE, by and with the advice of 0 Privy Council for Canada, We do, by this 0 Proclamation, authorize all persons in office officers of Canada and all functionaries in Canada and all Judges of the Dominion and Province Courts in Canada, who, at the time of the demise the Crown by Our Royal Brother, were duly lawfully holding or were duly and lawfully posse of or invested in any office, place or employment civil or military, within our Dominion of Canad or who held commissions under the former Sovereig and all functionaries who exercised any professi by virtue of any such commissions, to several continue in the due exercise of their respecti duties, functions and professions, for which Our Proclamation shall be sufficient warrant.

AND WE DO ORDAIN that all incumbents of sir offices and functions and all persons holding commissions as aforesaid shall, as soon hereaft as possible, take the usual and customary oath allegiance to Us before the proper officer or office hereunto appointed.

AND WE Do hereby require and command all 0 loving subjects to be aiding, helping and assisting all such officers of Canada and other functionar in the performance of their respective offices a
